

The Johnson Park Apartments Supportive Housing Program (JPA IV) provides affordable permanent supportive housing to women years of age and older with mental health disabilities or dual diagnosed.

Working with your Case Manager, you will establish a Service / Intervention Plan with a strategy and timeline designed to meet your goals, build hope and develop confidence so you can live securely and independently, participate in job training and/or obtain employment.

Program is JPA IV Supportive Housing conveniently located in the City of Utica in recently remodeled homes. Each woman will have her own efficiency or 1 bedroom apartment in a beautiful and clean community. Handicap adaptable / accessible apartments are available too.
