Referral Process:

The Oneida County (OC) Dept. of Mental Health and Mohawk Valley (MV) Housing Coalition / Utica OC Continuum of Care with over 50 area organizations work together to provide a continuum of services. All referrals will be made to the OC Adult Single Point of Access & Accountability and Central NY Services, Inc.

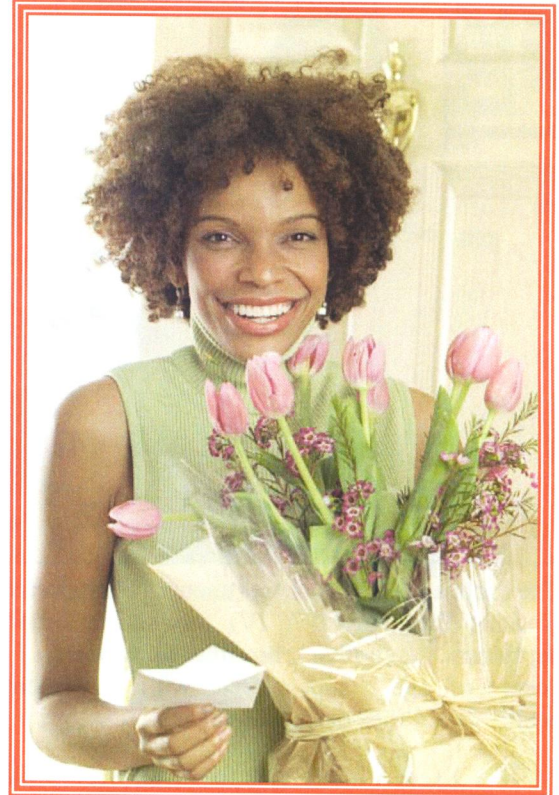

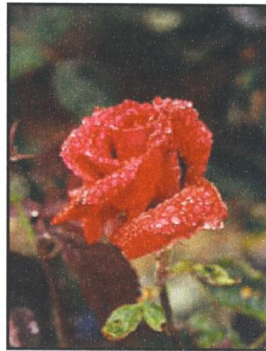
Just Right For Me - JPA IV Supportive Housing Program



The Johnson Park Apartments Supportive Housing Program (JPA IV) provides affordable permanent supportive housing to women 18 years of age and older with mental health disabilities or dual diagnosed.

At JPA IV, a woman can focus on successfully living in a supportive, structured, and safe environment that is free from survival-related anxiety and be engaged in her treatment program. Working with your Case Manager, you will establish a Service / Intervention Plan with a strategy and timeline designed to meet your goals, build hope and develop confidence so you can live securely and independently, participate in job training and/or obtain employment.

JPA IV Supportive Housing Program is conveniently located in the City of Utica in recently remodeled homes. Each woman will have her own efficiency or 1 bedroom apartment in a beautiful and clean community. Handicap adaptable / accessible apartments are available too.



Eligibility

- Homeless woman with a significant risk of continuous homelessness.
- Has a primary Mental Health Diagnosis or
- Has a Dual Diagnosis.
- Participate in Supportive Services.
- Meet TANF low income eligibility requirements.
